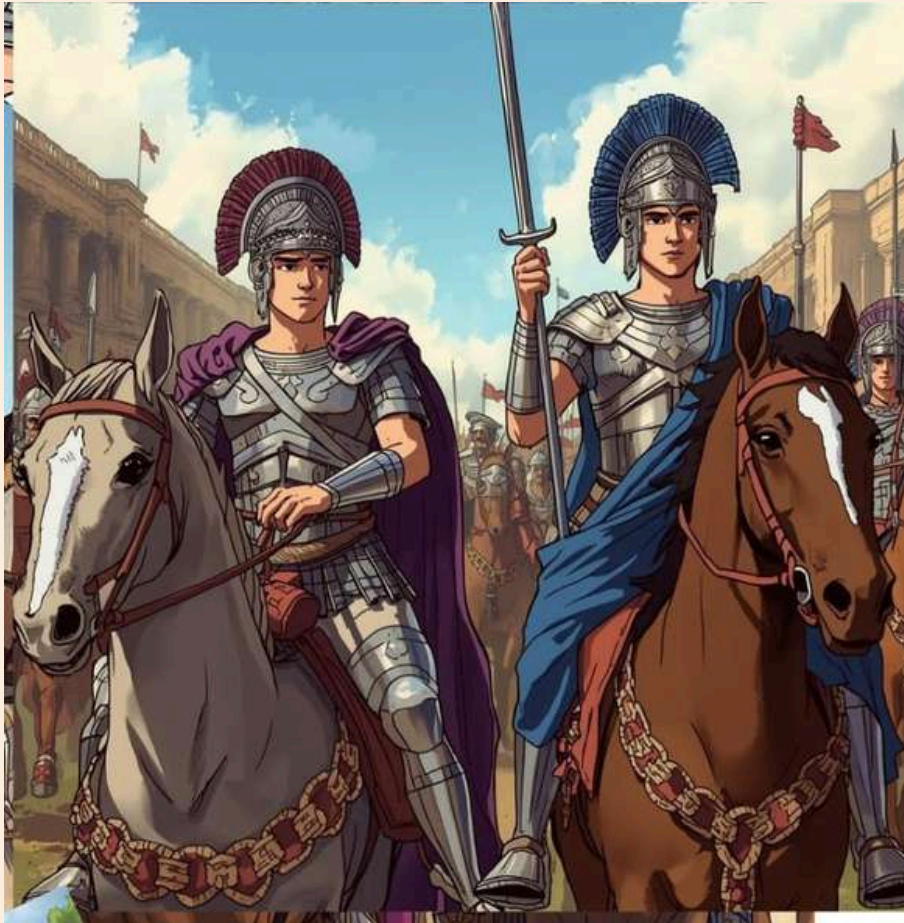


# Shakespeare: A Graphic Anthology
