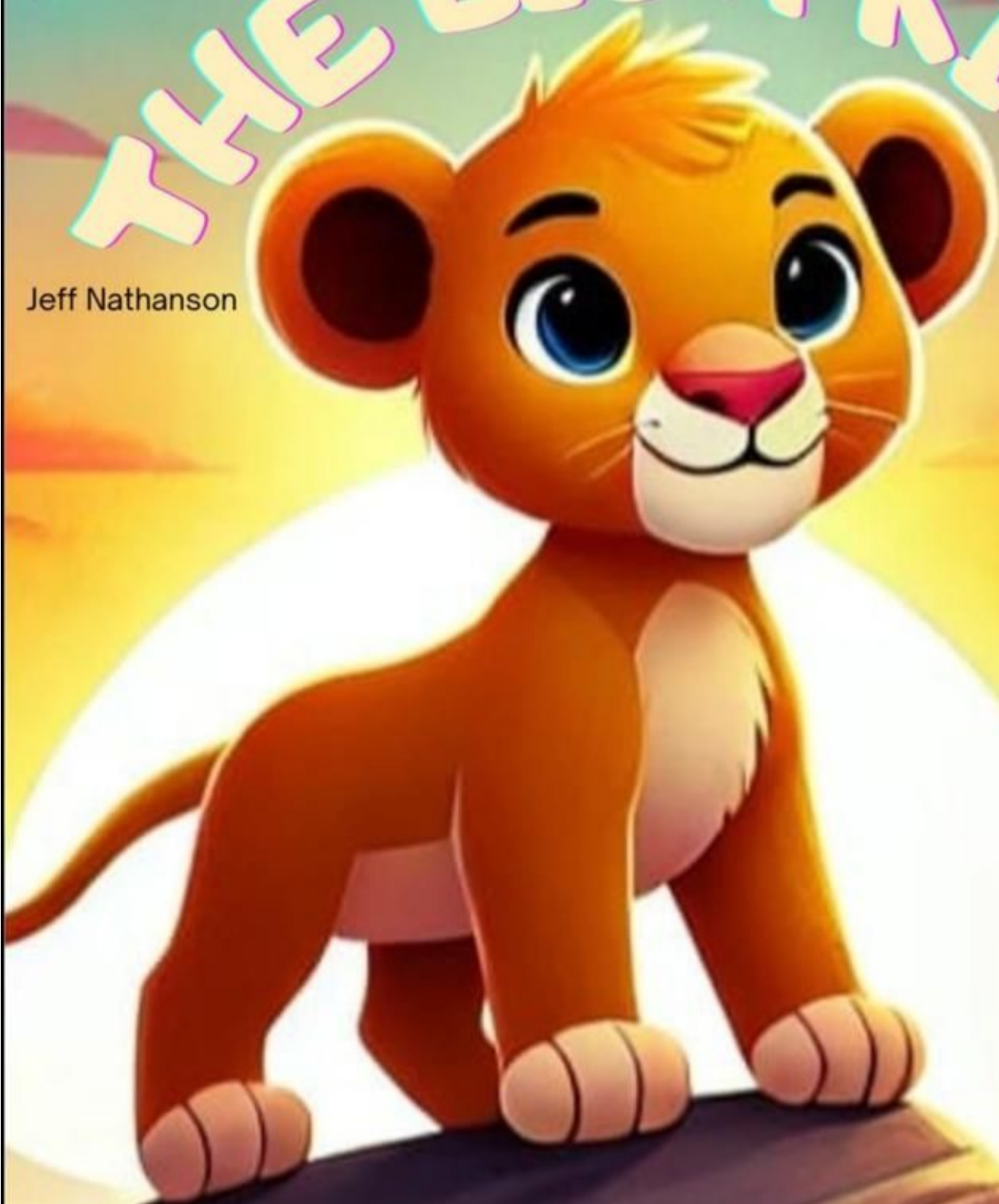

mean, laughing hyenas!**



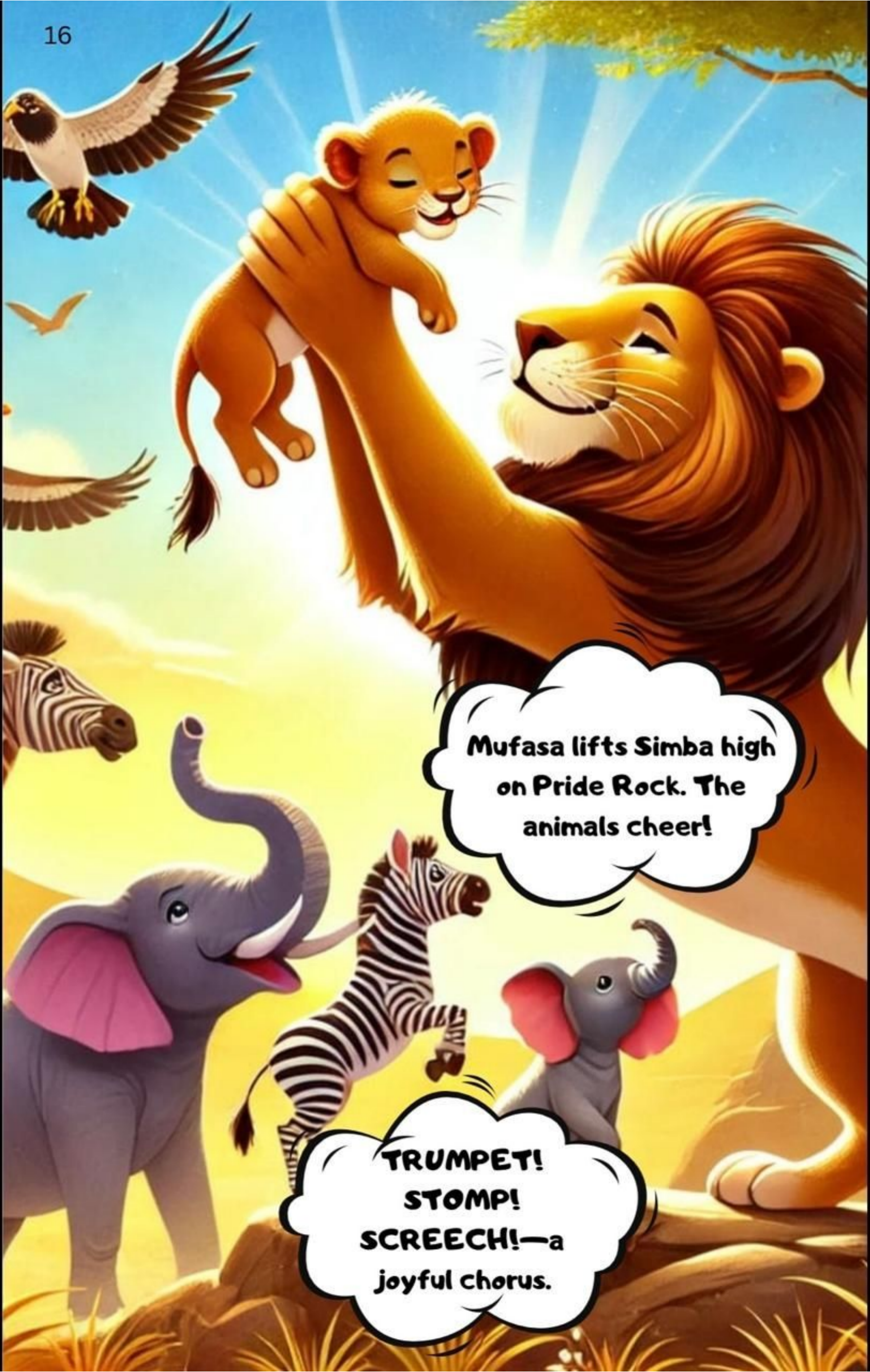
The lion king, Ahadi, watches Mufasa and says, "A great king thinks of others before himself."
